With recent changes to the structuring of first responders also comes a change to how equipment is replaced and supplied.

A compilation of the equipment that can be replaced to the first responders in our immediate area that Spiritwood and Big River Ambulance monitor is below and not restricted to only items listed. It is a guideline that is to be used to replace what is classified as “disposable equipment”.

It is necessary to keep track of equipment replaced and handed out, so located in the supply area will be a “First Responder Equipment List”, where one will document equipment that was given back the first responder. This can either be on a call (if time permits) or if individuals come to either base to pick it up.

Disposable Equipment

- Non-Rebreather Oxygen Masks (Adult & Pediatric)
- Nasal Cannula Oxygen
- Cold Packs
- Hot Packs
- 250ml Bottle of Normal Saline
- Multi-Trauma Dressing
- Triage Tags
- Triangular Bandages
- 4 x 4’s
- Tensor Bandages
- Roller Sterile Cling
- Abdominal Pads
- Face Masks
- Eye Pads
- Q-Tips
- Medical Tape
- Alcohol Swabs

It is suggested that any item not listed and distributed to ensure the first responder coordinator is made aware to either amend the list to include or to rationalize why it should remain off the list and no longer dispersed.

If any doubt is present to replace or not, contact management for direction.
